RE: Student and Adult Meal Price Increase for 2017-2018

DATE: May 1, 2017

Meal price increases for both students and adults will take place in August with the new school year. The increases were approved by the Board in April.

Each year Child Nutrition Services must review current student meal prices and submit data through the Texas Department of Agriculture. Calculated pricing is determined and as a result, current prices remain the same or an increase is required. The outcome for Aldine is an increase in meal prices.

* Breakfast for all students will continue to be free and is dependent upon high and sustained participation.

Adult meal prices are reviewed yearly as required to ensure food, labor, and operation expenses are covered. Child Nutrition Services does not receive any funding for adult meals. A necessary increase has been determined for the upcoming school year.
